How to enter: Submit your entry into the Hook, Line & Measure competition by reporting any fish within the Camden Local Government Area and submitting details with the Hook, Line & Measure entry form on Camden Council's website.

Eligibility: The competition is open to all ages but will require Parent/Guardian consent for persons under the age of 18.

If you are under the age of 18, you warrant that you have obtained the consent of your parent or legal guardian to enter the Prize Draw subject to these Terms and Conditions and that the parent/guardian has read, understood, and agreed to the Terms and Conditions.

Entrants must reside within the Greater Sydney Area.

Camden Council employees, volunteers, contractors, consultants, Committee members, their families and household members are ineligible to enter.
