

## *Crowea exalata*

**Botanic name:**  
*Crowea exalata*

**Common name:**  
Waxflower

**Family:**  
Rutaceae

**Typical height:**  
Up to 1m

**Typical width:**  
5-7m

**Typical growth rate:**  
Fast

**Typical habit:**  
It is found on the east coast, ranges and the slopes on the western side of the ranges. It grows in dry sclerophyll forest in sandy soil.

**Foliage:**  
Lime green glossy foliage

**Flowers:**  
flowers during most months of the year, resting only in extremes of heat and cold, and with flushes in autumn and spring.

**Site requirements:**  
A sheltered position in sandy soil is the ideal situation but *Crowea exalata* will grow well in richer soil in half to full sun, with some care whilst it becomes established
