Found in sandplains and soil composed of sandy clay

Foliage:

Bold and handsome foliage, slightly blue-green. Leaves are simple and widely spaced.

Flowers:

As early as December new flower buds can be seen with ornamental scales. The pinkish flowers appear white as a result of a covering of white hairs.

Site requirements:

Full sun position for optimum flowering. Any garden soil is suitable if it is lime free. Staking is advisable as plants are weakly rooted.
