ORD01 ELECTION OF MAYOR - 2024/2026

The General Manager vacated the Chair for the election of the Mayor and Deputy Mayor and the Manager Legal and Governance, as the Returning Officer, assumed the role of the Chairperson, the time being 6.35pm.

The Manager Legal and Governance, as Returning Officer, stated that two valid nominations had been received for the position of Mayor, being Councillor Cagney and Councillor Campbell, and as such the method of voting needed to be determined.

Motion: Moved Councillor Cagney, Seconded Councillor McLean that Council:

- i. determine the method of voting as open voting by way of show of hand; and
- hold an election for the office of Mayor at the Council Meeting of 15 October 2024 under the supervision of the Manager Legal and Governance as returning officer;
 and
- iii. once the election result is known, authorise the Manager Legal and Governance to declare the candidate with the majority vote the duly elected Mayor for the 2024/2026 term.

Councillors Cagney, Campbell, Fedeli, McLean, Sicari, Ferreri, Suri, Quinnell and Rahman voted in favour of the Motion.

No Councillors voted against the Motion.

The Manager Legal and Governance declared Councillor Cagney to be the duly elected Mayor for the 2024/2026 term.

- i. determine to appoint a Deputy Mayor for the period of the 2024/2026 Mayoral term; and
- ii. determine the method of voting as open voting by way of show of hands;
- iii. hold an election for the office of Deputy Mayor at the Council Meeting of 15 October 2024 under the supervision of the Manager Legal and Governance as returning officer; and
- iv. once the election result is known, authorise the Manager Legal and Governance to declare the candidate with the majority vote the duly elected Deputy Mayor for the period of the 2024/2026 Mayoral term.

- ii. directs the General Manager to notify the Electoral Commissioner for NSW of Council's decision within seven days of the decision.
