Before you touch it, check with an adult.

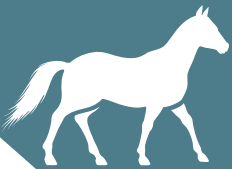
Hear a laughing Kookaburra or calling Magpie.
